The Main House has 3 good-sized bedrooms, with the principal being the largest and having the luxury of an en-suite bathroom. In both properties the living and sleeping areas are perfectly distributed and are separated by a passageway

The location could hardly be better, just a 10-minute walk into town with perfect access and on a 1,000m2 lowmaintenance plot with a further 3,000m2 plot with fruit trees 50 metres away.

The interior of both villas is excellent and both have Air Conditioning, mains electricity and mains water, both agricultural for the plot and vegetable garden and drinking water. The main villa has 12 solar panels, and subsequently, there are no bills.
