On entering the property you will find a lovely bright lounge and dining area where you will find the benefit of a log burner perfect for the cooler winter months. There are three good sized bedrooms and two large bathrooms decorated to a lovely standard ready for you to drop your bags and instantly enjoy your life in the sun.

The kitchen is fitted with numerous units topped with granite worktops and another great space for dining, and also a lovely sized utility room, always a bonus. Torre del Rico is a small village in the Spanish municipality of Jumilla, known for a 16th-century fortified tower that served as a refuge and symbol of power.

The tower has been restored and is now a cultural and social centre, with the surrounding area developing into a caserío (hamlet) with a population of about 99 as of 2009. The village is located in the Region of Murcia, near the border with the Valencian Community, and is situated on a hill overlooking a plain in the Carce highlands.
